NDRRA FLOOD RESTORATION WORKS

Location: East and West of Allora (Southern Downs)

Client: Southern Downs Regional Council

Duration: 3 months

DESCRIPTION

The Southern Downs Regional Council sustained significant damage to their unsealed road network from ex-Tropical Cyclone Debbie in 2017. Joe Wagner Group delivered a competitively tendered package of works across 34 roads in the North East of the Council area.

Works included:

- 27 kilometres of heavy grading, incorporating 5,700m³ of gravel top across this area
- 6,700m³ of gravel resheeting across 16.1 kilometres, including clearing of table drains and reinstating roadside furniture
- Minor structure repairs, removal of debris and clearing of pipes

In order to meet Council timeframes, work was undertaken across several sites concurrently. Works were overseen daily by a Council inspector enabling variations to be identified and understood.

Traffic management was undertaken in association with formally developed traffic management plans and implemented onsite by our qualified staff.

We developed a great rapport with both the client and the local community, receiving excellent feedback about the quality of our work. The project was completed successfully to local government compliance on time and on budget.
